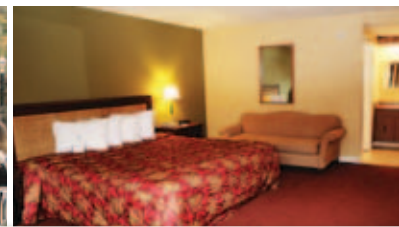

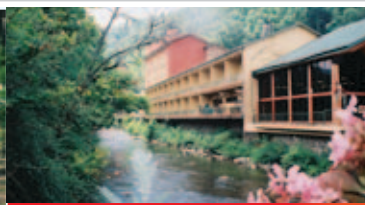

How to get to River Terrace Resort & Convention Center

From Knoxville McGhee-Tyson Airport:

From U.S. 129 North, take the I-40 East ramp toward Asheville, North Carolina. Take I-40 East to the 407 Exit toward Sevierville, Pigeon Forge and Gatlinburg. Turn right onto Highway 66 and travel South to U.S. 441. In Sevierville, proceed to Forks of the River Bypass to U.S. 441. Turn right onto U.S. 441 and travel through Pigeon Forge to Gatlinburg. Veer right onto East Parkway/441. Turn at Traffic Light 5 onto River Road.

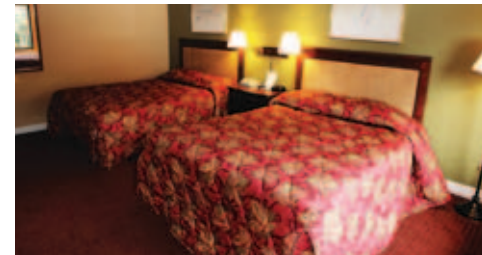
Distance from McGhee-Tyson Airport to River Terrace Resort & Convention Center: 44.1 miles

From Atlanta, Georgia:

Take I-75 North to Knoxville, Tennessee. Once in Knoxville, take I-40 East toward Asheville, North Carolina. Take I-40 East to the 407 Exit toward Sevierville, Pigeon Forge and Gatlinburg. Turn right onto Highway 66 and travel South to U.S. 441. In Sevierville, proceed to Forks of the River Bypass to U.S. 441. Turn right onto U.S. 441 and travel through Pigeon Forge to Gatlinburg. Veer right onto East Parkway/441. Turn at Traffic Light 5 onto River Road.

From Cherokee, North Carolina:

Take U.S. 441 North toward Gatlinburg, Tennessee. Bear right onto 441 to Gatlinburg. Continue on Parkway and turn at Traffic Light 5 onto River Road.

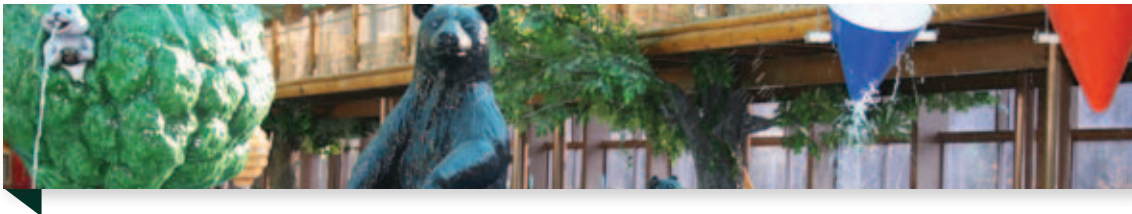


Wild Bear Falls Water Park

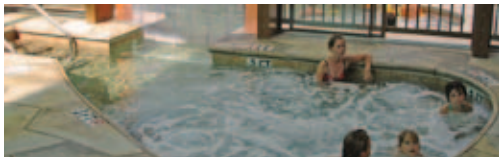
Westgate's Wild Bear Falls is the latest expansion to Westgate Smoky Mountain Resort in Gatlinburg, Tennessee. This mountain-themed, world-class family indoor water park features a state-of-the-art retractable roof, taking Mother Nature out of the equation! Guests can enjoy comfortable conditions year round. At more than 60,000 square feet, this is the largest indoor water park resort in the South and the fifth largest in the country. 300,000 gallons of water flow through the park daily.

Wild Bear Falls is an idyllic break for both parents and kids, offering an atmosphere that sets aside bonding time and a safe, supervised yet independent kid-friendly atmosphere that allows parents a chance to relax with children visible nearby. Ramsey Cascades

An interactive tree house play structure for kids of all ages, Ramsey Cascades includes a 300-gallon bucket that releases water over the entire structure, two wild and slippery slides, and several areas to control the water flow of water spouts.

Little Pigeon River

A zero depth spray playground for toddlers only.

Cades Cove

Guests slip into a relaxed state as they float leisurely down a 900' Lazy River (Tubes Allowed).



Clingman's Dome

A thrilling 350' long tube slide ride to enjoy.

Laurel Falls
