Shop for antiques at Renninger's Antiques in Mount Dora.

31.

Work your way through a fun-filled corn maze. Every year features a new and unique corn maze design with twisting pathways and more. Adventures include a one-acre and a 6-acre maze with lots of paths. (longandscottfarms.com)

Celebrate harvest season with an old-fashioned grape stomp at **Lakeridge Winery**. Or visit anytime for special festivals, free winery tours and tastings. (lakeridgewinery.com)
